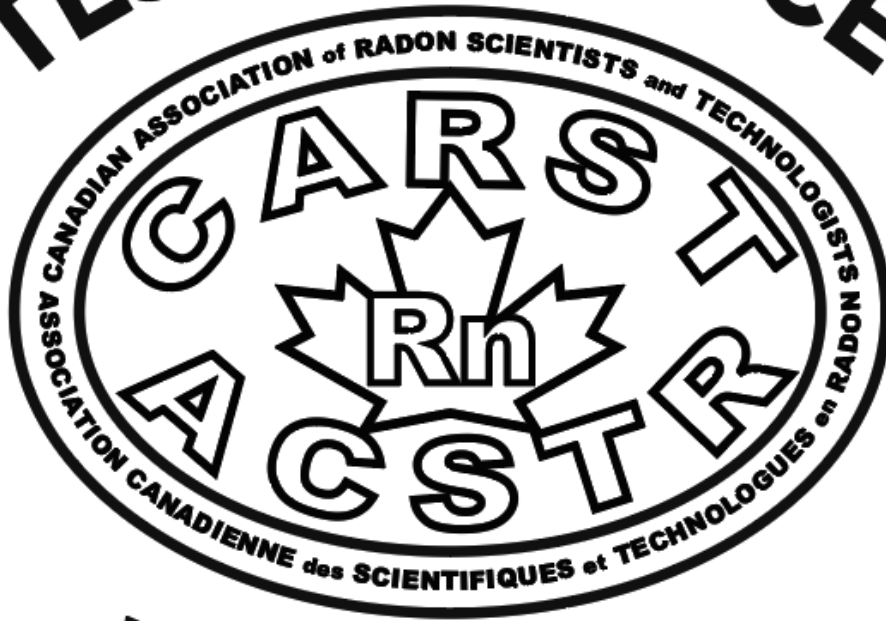


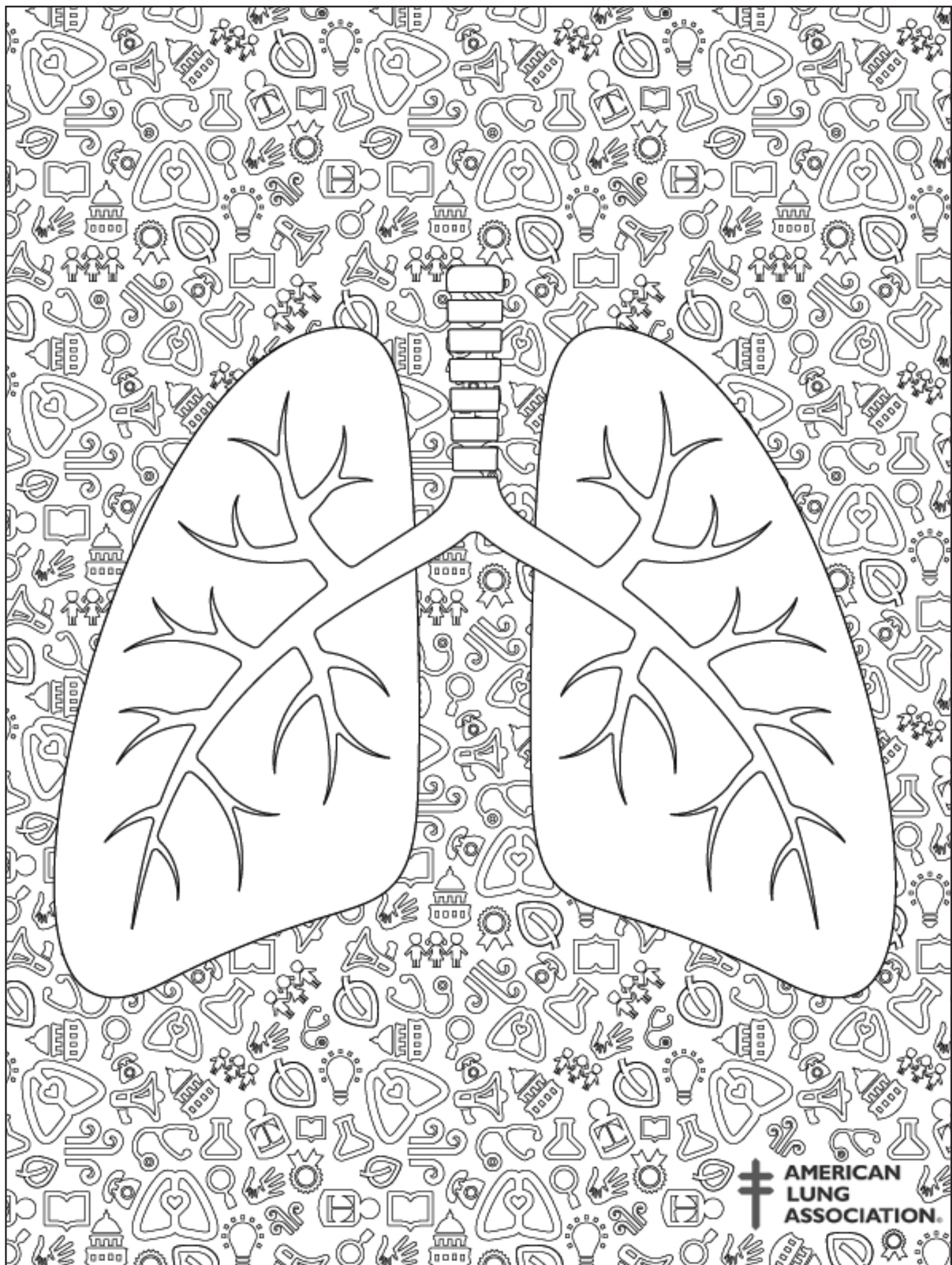

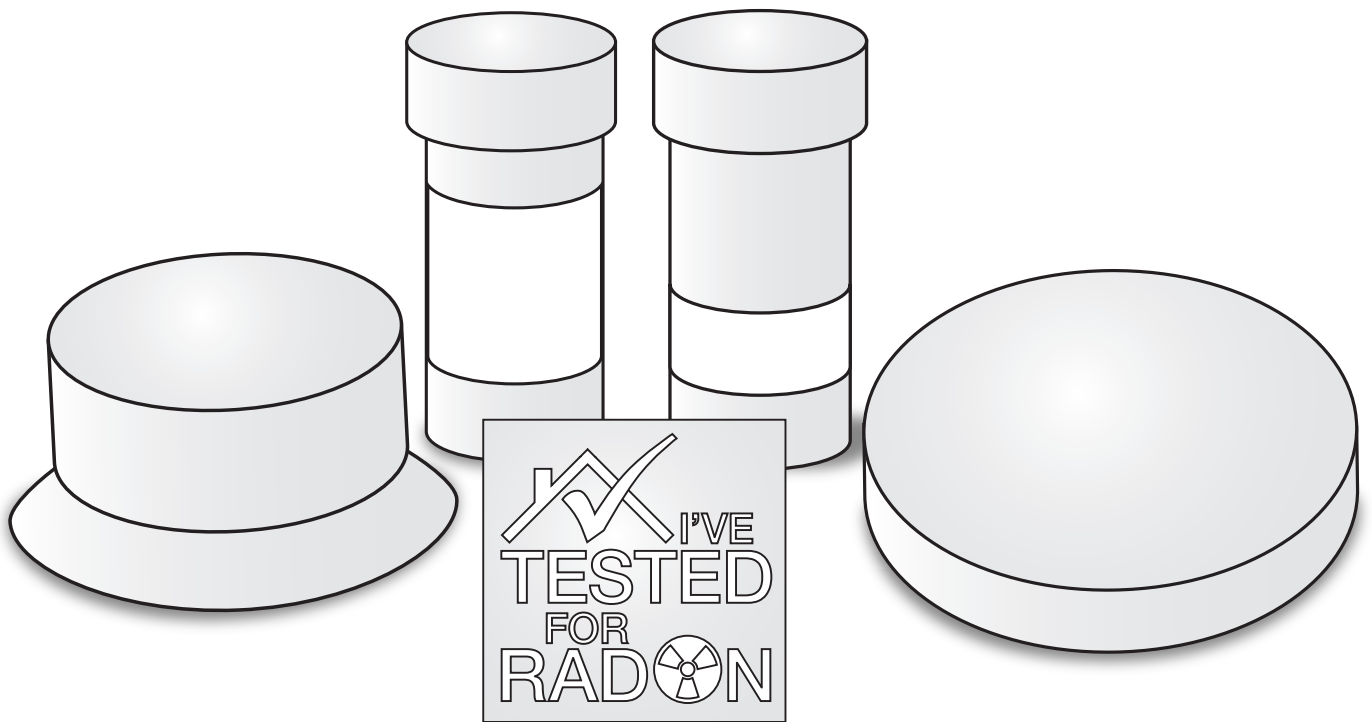


Ask your employer if they have tested for radon.





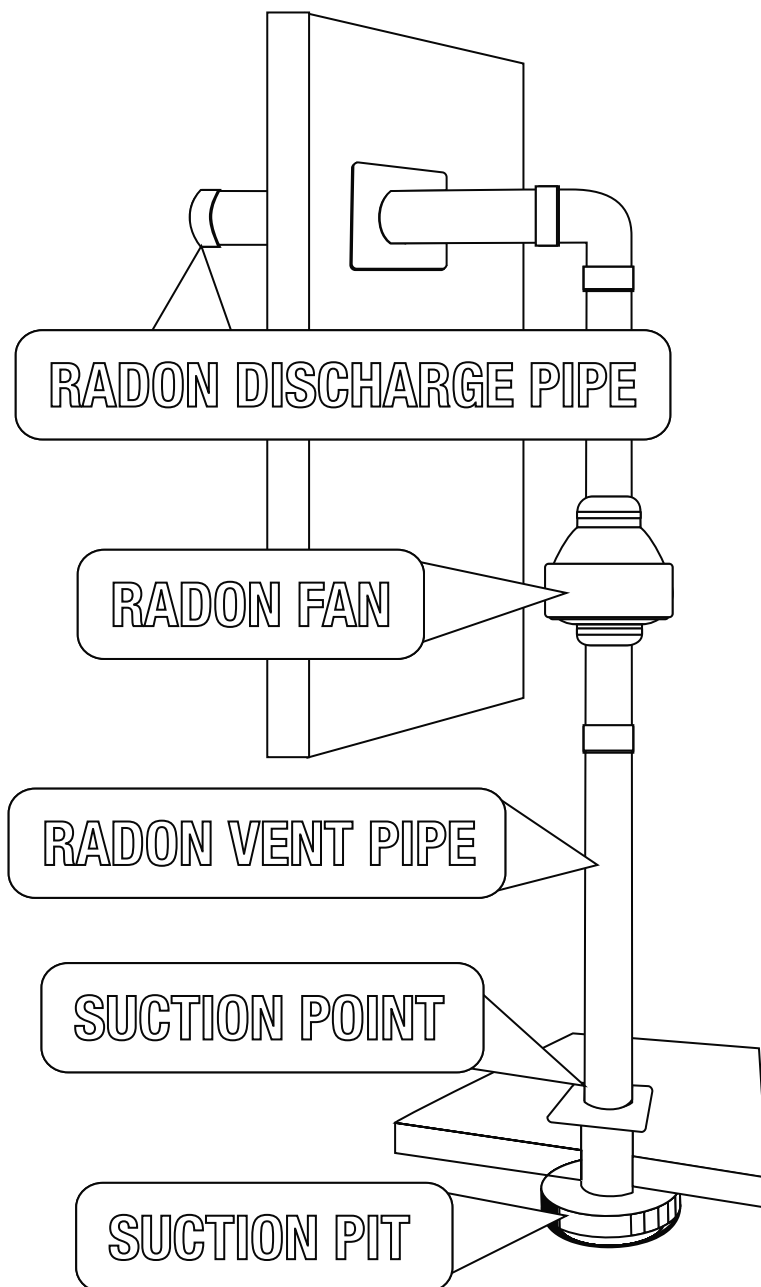
Radon detectors come in all shapes and sizes... Just test for radon.



Test your home for radon using a long-term radon test.



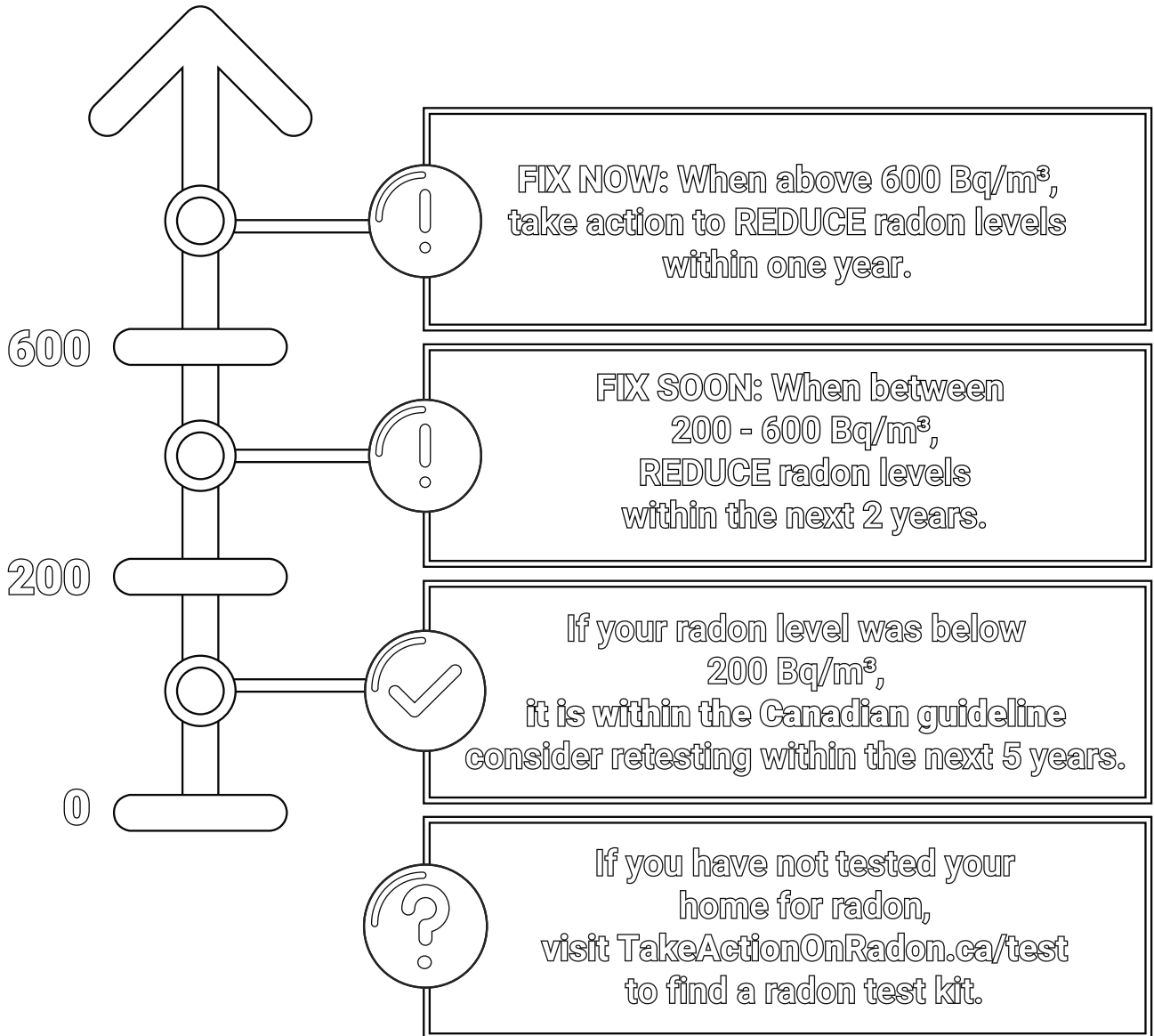
Reducing radon through RADON MITIGATION is a proven and effective method.



When you receive your radon test report, determine if the levels need to be reduced and make sure you take action to reduce your radon levels

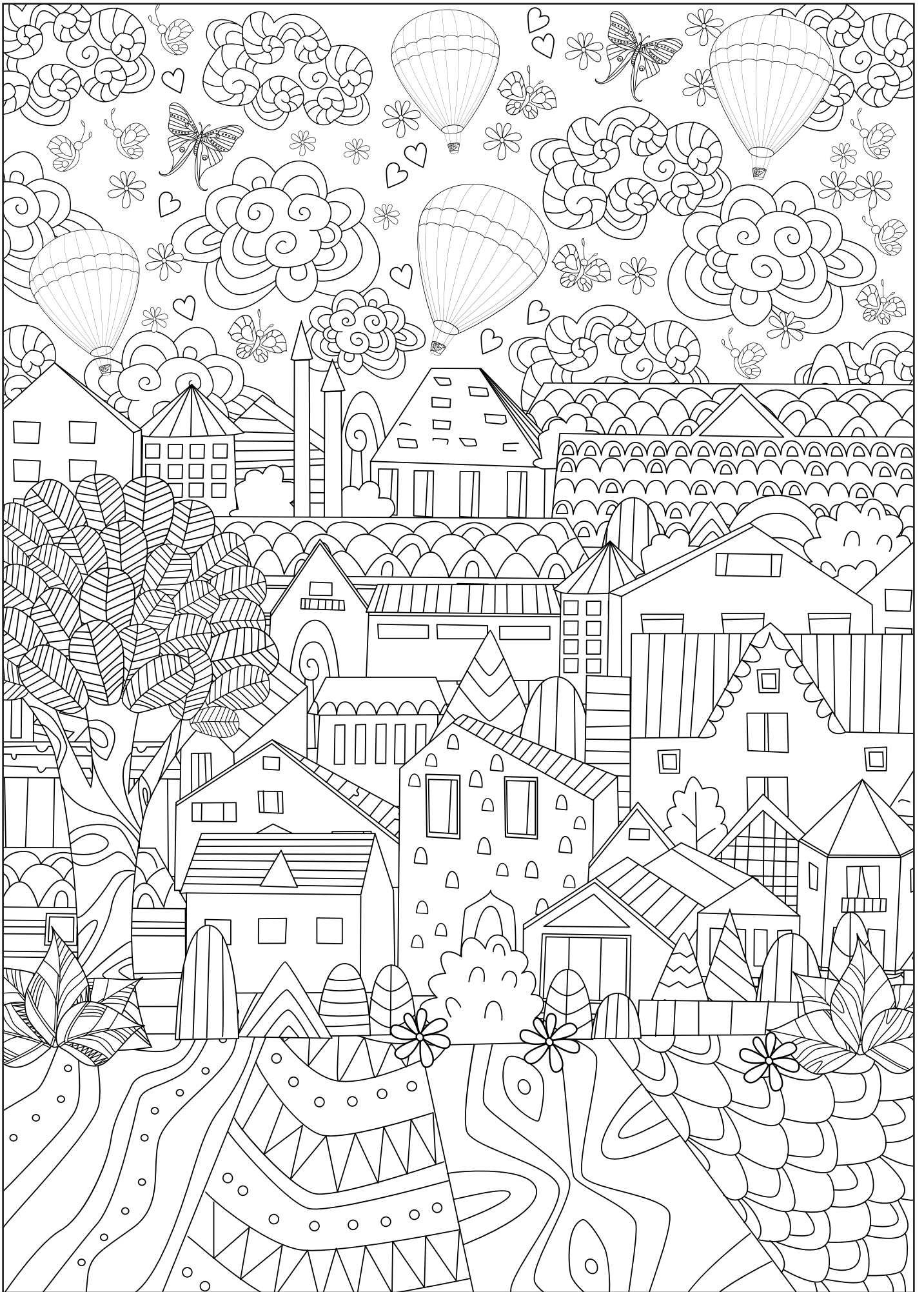


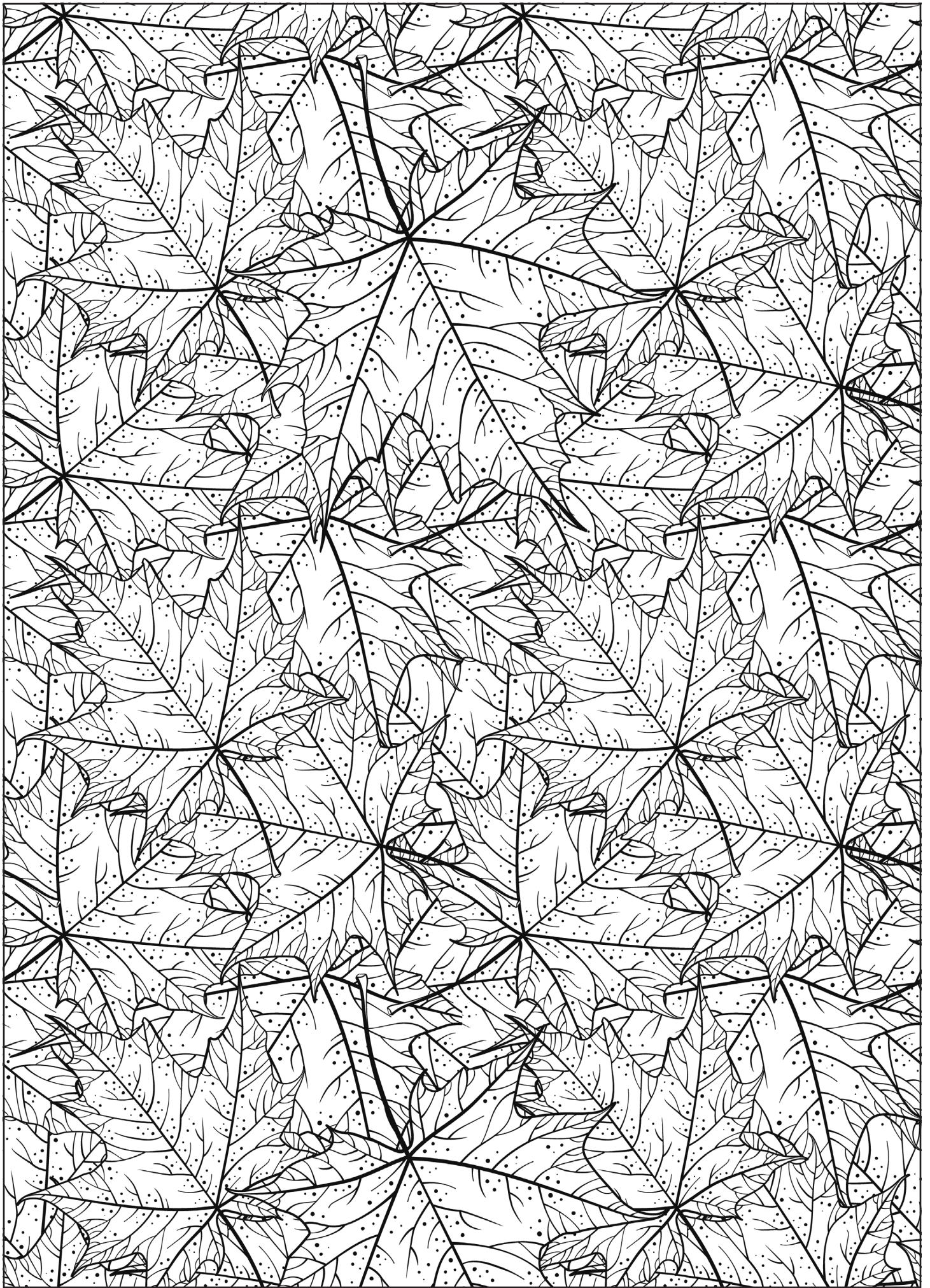

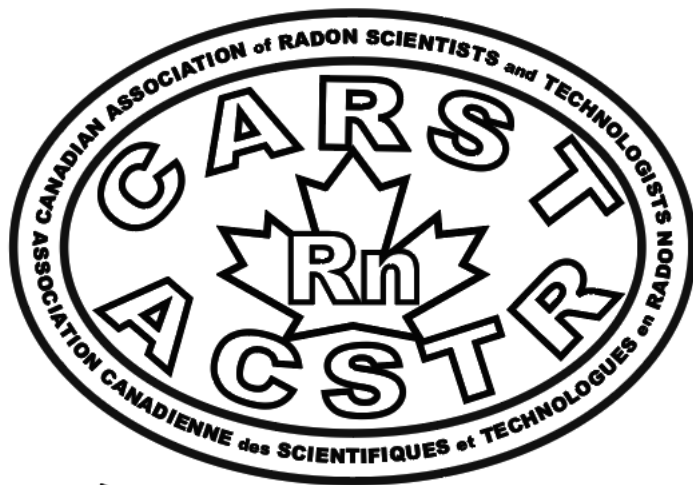
